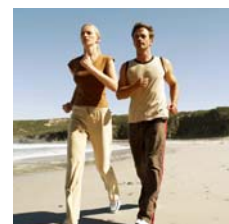
entertained by Arunn Jothidas, enjoyed the company of new people and older acquaintances and took lots of photos some of which are on Facebook.

## Recipe of the week—OVALTINE ICE-CREAM CAKE

Thanks to Vincor for this great recipe!



**Ingredients & Quantities:** Hot Water 30g

**Biscuit Base:**  
Digestive Biscuits Bits 60g  
Melted Butter 25g

**Ice Cream:**  
Light Cream 300g  
Condensed Milk 36g  
Gelatine 1pc  
Ovaltine Drink Powder 45g

**Decoration:**  
Finger Biscuit moderate - depends how much you like :)

**Method:** *\*No fire is needed\**

### Biscuit Base

1. Mix the Digestive biscuit bits and the melted butter together and spread flatly inside the cake-baking tin.

### Ice Cream

1. Pour the Ovaltine powder into hot water and dissolve it.
2. Beat the light cream up to 70% for later use.
3. Use slow heat to heat up the condensed milk. Put the gelatine afterwards and stir well.
4. Add the mixture of condensed milk and Ovaltine into the light cream and stir well.
5. Pour all into the cake tin and put into the freezer for ½ hr or more for stabilization.
6. Done!
